

Dining and Entertainment Options in Cleveland

Gay bars:

--*Cocktails Cleveland*: A 15-minute car ride from the hotels. Two levels, drinks, a patio, and usually events (drag shows or themed parties). Not much of a dance bar. Visit <https://www.facebook.com/CocktailsCleveland/> for more details.

--*Leather Stallion Saloon*: A 5-minute car ride from the hotels. Good place to socialize and have a drink and has a large patio; sometimes there's a DJ. Has a pool table. Visit <http://www.leatherstallion.com/> and <https://www.facebook.com/The-Stallion-Leather-Stallion-Saloon-104975149546435/>

--*Twist Social Club*: A 15-minute car ride from the hotels. Food until 10PM. Great place to relax and socialize, or to dance. Has a patio. Sometimes has themed parties/events. Visit <https://www.twistsocialclub.com/> and <https://www.facebook.com/TwistSocialClub/> for more details.

--*Vibe Bar & Patio*: A 10-minute car ride from the hotels. Nice place to have a drink and socialize. Has a patio and a pool table. Visit <http://vibecleveland.com/> and <https://www.facebook.com/vibe.cleveland/> for more details.

Additional dining and entertainment options: The following areas are not necessarily "gay", but are welcoming to all:

--*Playhouse Square district (area immediately surrounding the Crowne Plaza Hotel (approximately 1/2 mile from Holiday Inn Express))*. Click "back" to find the link "Playhouse Square Amenities" to discover all the dining and entertainment options within a very short walk of the hotel.

--*E. 4th Street entertainment district*: This district is a 10-minute walk (1/2 half mile) from Crowne Plaza Hotel and the Holiday Inn Express. The street is closed off to vehicle traffic. --*Flats East Bank entertainment district*: This district is a 10-minute car ride from Crowne Plaza Hotel and Holiday Inn Express.
